

Sound at Nissan

A new residential area is planned to develop in the harbor area of Halmstad by 2021 and Sound at Nissan aims at using sound as a tool in the urban development process. By involving local communities and other parties interested in the processes, new and challenging questions and opinions have been raised in a series of sound walks arranged by Harp Art Lab.

In the weekend of September 9-11 we are entering a new phase in the project when ten International artists and one Phd Researcher will co-operate with local inhabitants in a series of sound expeditions, installations and performances along the river Nissan - from the harbor, passing by the city center and all the way up to the rural areas of Slottsmöllan.

This guide book is your companion in the expeditions to the sound art projects along the river Nissan.

Projects

Upstream Nissan, Kajsa Magnarsson will make a sound installation on the small deserted 'Rabbit Island' - consisting of a rave party at night and its aftermath the day after.

Laurie Tompkins '600 Halmstad Songs', consists of one 'song' for each apartment, which will be built in the harbor 2021. Some of the songs will be presented as a sound installation at the site of the future residential area.

Johannes Bergmark invites the audience to 'Play the Bridge for the Fish!' at the walking bridge near the library in Halmstad.

'Soundtrack Nissan' is a four kilometer long sound installation by Mikael Ericsson, which consists of field recordings made by the participants from the soundwalks organized by Harp Art Lab. The sounds from Nissan will be relocated, displaced, intertwined and mashed up with other samples and sites.

Projects


In the project 'Deep in the Image' microscopic water samples from and film clips from Nissan turns into an animation by Aga Jarzabowa och Maciej Baczyk, with music by Pin Park.


Follow Klara Andersson on an 'Expedition' through layers of reality, stories and experiences along the river Nissan or listen to her 'Inflammatory speech in noise' - for my generation, against the passivity, through the body, for the future!

Ann-Louise Liljedahl makes an installation/performance at an abandoned crane in the harbor, transforming the sound into an 'Echo of Iron'.

At the old railway bridge, Julie Ericsson put layers of sound filled with memories from journeys through distant cities in her new piece 'Ferrovie dello Stato'.

Conor McCafferty is researching the use of sound maps as a means of urban analysis and participatory engagement, asking questions on how built environment professionals and residents can develop their understanding of urban spaces through sound. What will happen at Tullkammarkajen? Today: sheds, concrete, machinery, open space. Someday soon: apartments, greenery and people living their lives in the city. In the 'Workshop - Tullkammarkajen', we try to find out what we have, and what we are missing.




